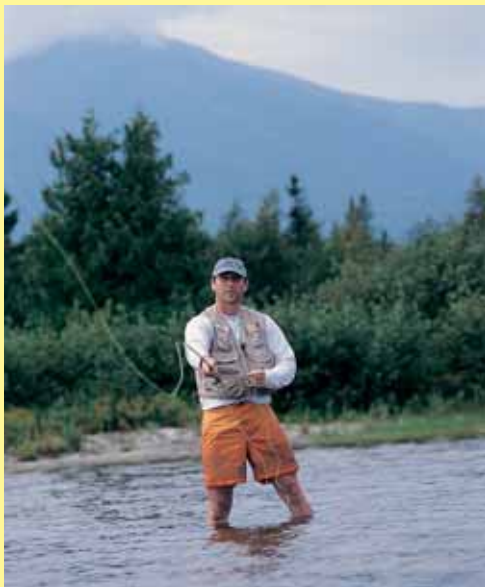

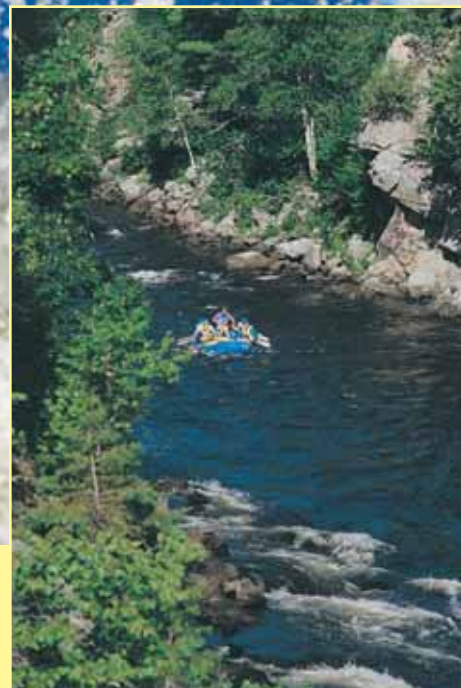

The Penobscot River: A pool-drop river with spectacular, complex rapids dropping into calm pools of water which allow time to catch your breath before tackling the next rapid. The 90 foot walls of Ripogenus Gorge give way to breathtaking views of the mountains of Baxter Park including Mt. Katahdin, Maine's highest mountain. Surfing spots and a natural water slide are highlights of a Penobscot River trip.

The Kennebec River: A deep water gorge where compression waves create a continuous roller coaster ride for nearly six miles. The Alleyway and the most famous rapid, Magic Falls, offer some of the largest breaking waves in the Northeast. The last six miles of the ride mellows a bit and guests get to swim and paddle "duckies" alongside their rafts.

The Dead River: Ten times a year this 16 mile run comes screaming to life in a whitewater bonanza, featuring intense rapids like Hayden's Landing, Big Poplar and the infamous Mine Field. Spring has the biggest waterflows due to snow melt; fall has big warm water, spectacular foliage, and guaranteed fun!

The Katahdin Region is Maine's premier moose habitat with unparalleled opportunities for wildlife watching. You will never forget the experience of seeing these amazing animals in the wild. In addition to moose, wildlife commonly seen on our tours includes bald eagles, loons, osprey, great blue heron, Canada geese, whitetail deer, fox, and the occasional black bear.

MOOSE FACTS

- Moose is Maine's official State Animal
- Moose are the largest members of the deer family
- Moose can run 35 miles per hour and can easily swim 10 miles
- Hooves are their first line of defense. They can kick out in all directions.
- Moose can live up to 20 years
- The plural of moose is "moose."
- Only bull moose have antlers. They shed (fall off) in the winter.

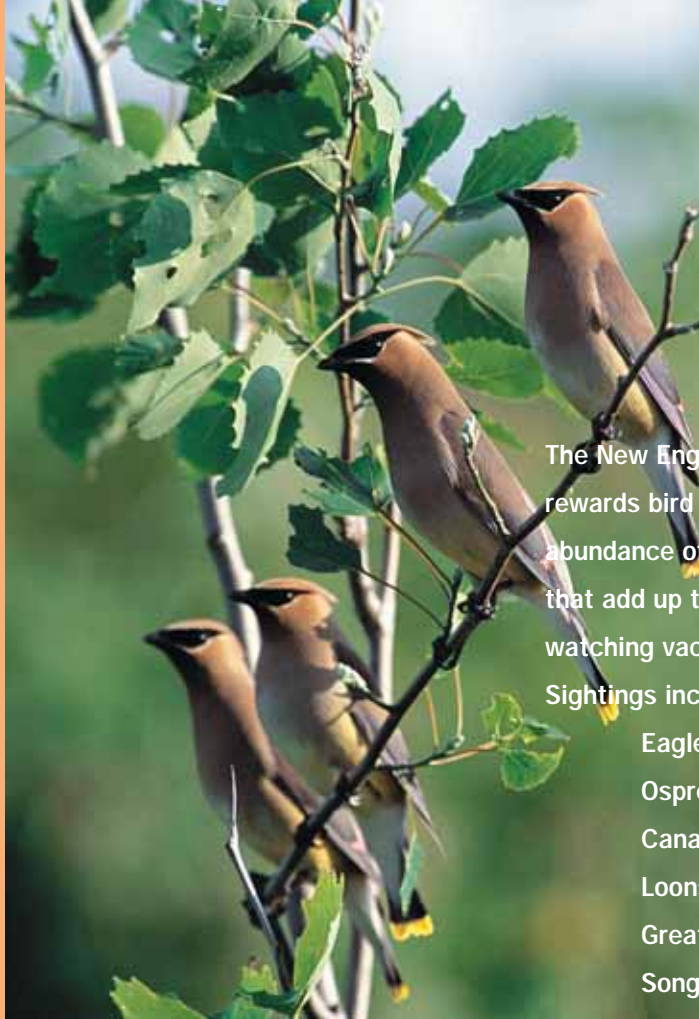

THE RICE FARM CAMPGROUND Our quiet and secluded campground is located adjacent to the award winning River Drivers Restaurant on the banks of the Penobscot River. It offers campsites, canvas cabin tents and cozy bunkhouses.

PENOBSCOT OUTDOOR CENTER (POC) Located just 2 miles before Baxter State Park, POC is home to our rafting base. This busy campground, located directly on Pockwockamus Pond, has spectacular views of Mt. Katahdin. It offers volleyball, hot tub, shower and bathroom facilities, casual dining and the Broken Paddle Pub.

RIPOGENUS GORGE extends from deep in Ripogenus Lake to the Cribworks Rapid. Whitewater rafters revere this Class V section for Exterminator, The Staircase, The Heaters, The Little Eddy and Bailing Eddy Rapids.



THE CRIBWORKS is Maine's most famous Class V rapid. Named for the huge cribwork dams from the historic log drives, it stands out today as one of the most challenging commercially rafted rapids east of the Mississippi River.



BIG AMBEJACKMOCKAMUS FALLS, "Big A", is a sharp S-bend in the river which builds from Class I to Class IV in the first of three drops that make up the rapid. The second and third drops offer fine surfing opportunities for rafters and kayakers alike.



NESOWADNEHUNG FALLS is the biggest single drop on the Penobscot River, loved by rafters, kayakers, and fishermen. Land-locked salmon can be seen jumping up the 10-foot drop during the annual spawning migration. It affords a great opportunity for surfing, climbing behind the falls, and fly fishing.



ABOL FALLS is a rocky Class II-III rapid that follows the Abol Deadwater. Two great hydraulics often soak rafters and somersault kayakers. It ends in a calm pool beside a large eddy on the right with a beautiful sandy beach and easy road access.



BIG POCKWOCKAMUS FALLS is one of the longer rapids on the Penobscot River. Guides, guests, and kayakers love it. It is a great rapid for learning to kayak, swimming in whitewater, or just enjoying the roller coaster ride over the waves.



THE NEVERS CORNER rafting take-out lies just a quarter mile after the end of Big Pockwockamus Falls, arguably the most exciting rapid encountered in the morning. Highly anticipated privies are available here.

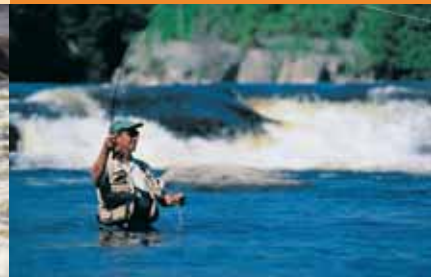
