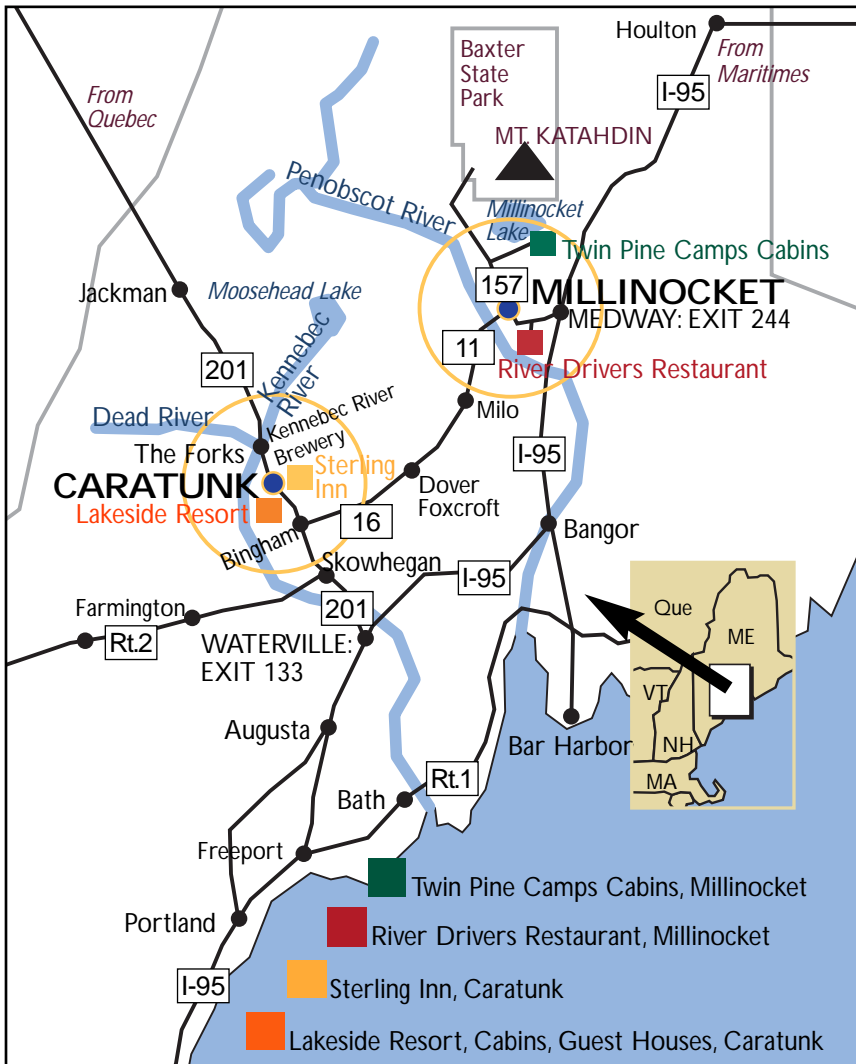

DIRECTIONS



TWIN PINE CAMPS LOG CABINS
Exit 244 (formerly 56) off I-95. Take Route 11/157 west towards Millinocket. Follow 157 and signs to Baxter State Park. We are located 8 miles out of town on Millinocket Lake. Our dirt road entrance is on the right just after a 35mph sign and a DOT sign for Twin Pines. If you pass North Woods Trading Post, you've gone too far. 207-723-5523.

RIVER DRIVERS RESTAURANT
Exit 244 (formerly 56) off I-95. Take Route 11/157 West towards Millinocket. You will travel through Medway and E. Millinocket. The road to the base is on your left exactly 8 miles from the exit off I-95. Follow the road just over one mile and you will see the entrance on the left. If you make a sharp right you have gone too far. 207-723-8475

**LAKESIDE RESORT BASE:
STERLING, SILVER COVE, POINT HOUSE**
Exit 133 (formerly 36) off I-95. Take Route 201N through Skowhegan (watch for right turn across the Kennebec River), go through Solon, Bingham, to Caratunk. The base entrance is on the left across from the Sterling Inn, 13 miles past Bingham. 207-672-5506 or 207-672-3369

PLEASE, PLEASE check your confirmation and directions carefully to be sure you are travelling to the correct location. Our Lakeside Resort Base & Twin Pine Camps Cabin locations are two hours apart and we don't want you to travel to the wrong place. The directions you receive in the mail should match the color of the destination. (ex: green for Twin Pine Camps, yellow for Lakeside Resort in Caratunk)
