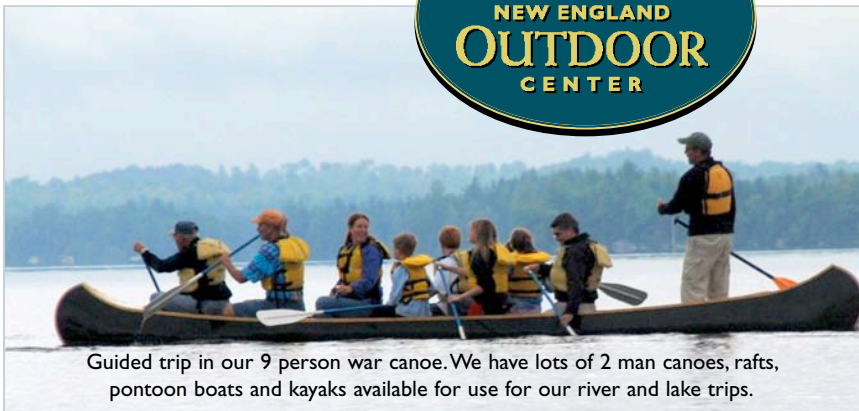

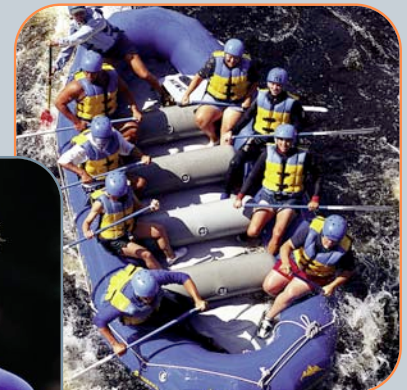

#### KENNEBEC RIVER & YOUTH ADVENTURE RESORT (Caratunk)

The Kennebec River is located in the heart of Maine's whitewater country with 12 miles of fast and deep-water flows daily. The upper Kennebec gorge is where you'll ride the thrilling roller coaster waves of Big Mama and the Three Sisters then plunge into boiling Magic Falls. Paddle your way down the lower river on sit-on-top kayaks to look for wildlife. The Kennebec River is an ideal introductory whitewater experience and/or for groups with younger members. Minimum age is 10 for the upper river. You're guaranteed to get wet in waves cresting from 4 to 8 feet high!

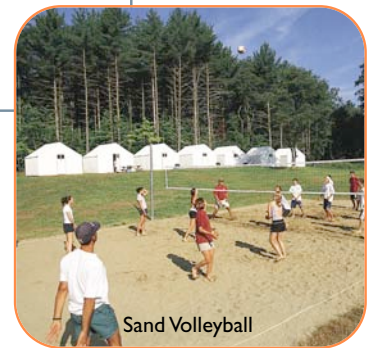


Outdoor pool and jacuzzi

## STEP ONE CONTINUED:

### **PENOBSCOT RIVER (Millinocket, ME)**

Rafting on the Penobscot River is one of the most spectacular and challenging river experiences in the Eastern U.S. The Penobscot River enjoys a reputation as a river of contrasts as it alternates between exhilarating rapids and breathtaking scenery. Rapids on the Penobscot River are short with sheer drops plunging into calm pools.

**AND THE GOOD NEWS IS...** we have options for all ages and abilities.

- Penobscot Full River – ages 15 and up
- High Adventure/Lower River – ages 10 and up
- Soft Adventure – ages 6 and up

### **Choose from the following lodging options:**

**Penobscot Outdoor Center** – features campsites and cabin tents, shower house, large spacious pavilion (great for socializing) with indoor hot tub & pool table, volleyball, canoeing, large outdoor area for a campfire, breakfast & dinner available on-site. Note: ALL Penobscot River trips generate from this location.

**Twin Pine Camps** – located on Millinocket Lake; features 10 lakeside cabins and 9 Guest Houses with varying capacities, a Rec building with indoor heated Jacuzzi, ping-pong, big screen TV with DVD, lake swimming, canoeing, kayaking, horseshoes, volleyball, basketball and more. All of the cabins have fully equipped kitchens, bathrooms, heat/electricity, bedding provided.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND HOW TO BOOK A RESERVATION:

Call our reservations office at 1.800.766.7238 as soon as you have selected possible dates so that we can check availability. Ask for a youth group specialist!

### WE WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- ☆ Which dates and activities would you like?
- ☆ How many nights are you staying and, what type of accommodations do you need?
- ☆ Number of people attending.
- ☆ What meals would you like prepared for you? Breakfast/Dinner? (A lunch or snack is usually provided with all daily activities)

### YOUTH DEPOSITS, CANCELLATIONS, REFUNDS

Within 10 days or an agreed upon date, once the reservation is made, we require a deposit of 10% of the total youth group reservation.

**Forty-five (45) days prior to the trip date**, we require additional payment to equal 50% of the total youth group reservation.

**Fourteen (14) days prior to arrival** for Lakeside Lodging in Caratunk numbers must be confirmed. This is contracted lodging and there is no refund on this lodging within 14 days.

**Ten (10) days prior to the group activity**, participant numbers must be confirmed and the balance paid in full.

**Cancellations made within ten (10) days** of the activity are non-refundable and non-transferable.

**\*\*Purchase orders are gladly accepted from schools.**

### WE SUPPLY

- ☆ Professionally trained licensed Maine Guides.
- ☆ All watercraft / life preservers / helmets / paddles.
- ☆ Shuttle bus transportation and all meals during your daily activity.
- ☆ We attempt to provide a videographer/photographer on every river trip.
- ☆ A mandatory orientation / safety / practice session before all activities.
- ☆ FREE Wet suits!

### YOU SUPPLY

Bathing suit / sneakers / wool or polar fleece jacket / windbreaker or rainwear. (*Do not wear cotton T-shirts, sweaters or jeans on the river*). You will need a dry change of clothes and a towel upon return from the trip. Proper footwear is required on all river trips (sneakers, river sandals, water shoes, etc must have heel straps – no flip flops or Crocs). We rent booties if needed.
