5. **I understand** that I am responsible, subject to the terms and conditions of this agreement, for the first **\$1000.00** of Collision Damage to the snowmobile. **THIS LIMITATIONS ON COLLISION DAMAGE APPLIES ONLY TO PHYSICAL DAMAGE TO THE SNOWMOBILE AND IS VOID IF CUSTOMER VIOLATES THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT OR HAS HAD AN ACCIDENT ON A FROZEN BODY OF WATER. COLLISION DAMAGE DOES NOT COVER THEFT OR LIABILITY.** _____ **(Initial)**
6. **I agree** to return all rental equipment by the agreed date in a clean condition to avoid any additional charges. I agree to pay the extra rental fees for any equipment returned late. If you are going to trailer a sled, it must be returned clean or we will charge you for cleaning.
7. **I agree** to comply with the safety regulations attached and rules and regulations in the State of Maine for snowmobile use.

Twin Pine Rentals Inc. Snowmobile Release Agreement

In consideration of the services of Twin Pine Rentals Inc., NEOC, their agents, owners, officers, volunteers, employees, and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on their behalf (hereinafter collectively referred to as "TPR"), I hereby agree to release, indemnify, and discharge TPR, on behalf of myself, my spouse, my children, my parents, my heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate as follows:

1. I acknowledge that my participation in guided snowmobile tours activities entails known and unanticipated risks that could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death, or damage to myself, to property, or to third parties. I understand that such risks simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity.

The risks include, among other things: riding on uneven snow covered terrain, changing snow conditions and variations in elevations; loss of control of the snowmobile; falls from snowmobile; passengers can be jolted, jarred, bounced, thrown about and otherwise shaken during rides; collision with other snowmobiles, participants, trees, rocks, and other man made or natural obstacles; snowmobiles are slippery when wet and accidents can occur while getting on and off; pinches, bruises, abrasions, strains, burns, cuts and lacerations; exhaustion; major injuries are a risk as are musculoskeletal injuries including head, neck and back injuries; injuries to internal organs; the negligence of participants, or other persons who may be present; steepness of slopes, snow depth, instability of snow pack or varying and difficult weather; exposure to temperature and weather extremes which could cause hypothermia, frostbite, frostnip, hypoxia, sunburn or dehydration; encounters with animals and wildlife; altitude sickness; high altitude pulmonary edema; exposure to potentially dangerous wild animals; insect bites and hazardous plant life; further, passengers can be thrown off the vehicle which can result in any of the above events occurring; equipment failure and mechanical and/or equipment problems; accidents or illness can occur in remote places without medical facilities; improper lifting or carrying; my own physical condition, and physical exertion associated with this activity.

Furthermore, TPR personnel have difficult jobs to perform. They seek safety, but they are not infallible. They might be unaware of a participant's fitness or abilities. They might misjudge the weather or other environmental conditions. They may give incomplete warnings or instructions, and the equipment being used might malfunction.

2. I expressly agree and promise to accept and assume all of the risks existing in this activity. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary, and I elect to participate in spite of the risks.

3. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless TPR from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action, which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity or my use of TPR's equipment or facilities, **including any such claims which allege negligent acts or omissions of TPR.**

4. Should TPR or anyone acting on their behalf, be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.

5. I certify that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may cause or suffer while participating, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further certify that I am willing to assume the risk of any medical or physical condition I may have.

6. In the event that I file a lawsuit against TPR, I agree to do so solely in the state of Maine, and I further agree that the substantive law of the state shall apply in that action without regard to the conflict of law rules of that state. I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining document shall remain in full force and effect.

By signing this document, I acknowledge that if anyone is hurt or property is damaged during my participation in this activity, I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against TPR on the basis of any claim from which I have released them herein. I also agree that this document is valid for subsequent visits and participation at TPR. I have had sufficient opportunity to read this entire document. I have read and understood it, and I agree to be bound by its terms.
